



# 2024 Priority North Park MAD Reballot

The services offered by the NPMAD (Park Blvd to 805) Engineering Report, which stipulates how funds can be spent, was written in a very restrictive way. It specifies an exact number of trees that can be planted, the number of streetlights that can be installed and which sidewalks can be steam cleaned. North Park has changed dramatically since the report was written in 1998.

An effort is underway to establish priorities for the future services and improvements desired by assessed property owners. The amount of services and improvements will have an impact on the property assessment to fund the special benefit services.

Committee Focus: Foster greater relationships with public and private entities to create projects that enhance the Boulevard, and create an improved environment for residents and businesses through continued advocacy, business development, a recruitment and retention program, and incubation strategies at our hubs.
