- Mid City Community Parking District FY26 Budget

  - 45% is what they say they give us but the BIA only receives around 60- 80k out of 400k
  - We are pushing back on any budget cuts, the meters are doubled but they are looking to reduce the budget from 45 to 15%
  - Another draft is due next week
