- Parking Management
  - FY25 Budget Pilot community shuttle
    - Goes down the Boulevard, parts of 30th st, University, Fairmount
    - It is free to people and cost \$30,000
    - Top 10 Priority Projects
      - Finally accomplished
      - Moving on to submitting the next ten
    - Angle parking Conversions adding to list of North Park conversions
      - 78 spaces added in 2023
      - 23 spaces are approved and awaiting installation by City
        - Working with people to inform them about why meter installment is important (education)
